“Hunter Station Bridge – Where Transportation Meets Conservation”

PennDOT faced significant design and construction challenges in replacing the original Hunter Station Bridge, among them the need to minimize impacts to threatened and endangered species of freshwater mussels. Prior to construction, more than 130,000 mussels were relocated to suitable habitats in six states.

This session covers the project team’s efforts to explore innovative ideas and work with stakeholders to find balanced project solutions. As a result, the range of these mussels in the region has been significantly broadened, positioning the species for future removal from the threatened and endangered species list.
